Here at the Two Rivers Medical Centre we feel Cervical Screening is a very important subject that can often get pushed aside. We want to be able to help decrease the incidents of Cervical Cancer and so we follow the national guidelines and invite all female patients between the ages of 25 to 49 every 3 years and ages 50 to 64 every 5 years.

Cervical cancer is the most common form of cancer that women can get under the age of 35. If you attend regularly for your cervical screening appointments, this can prevent up to 75% of instances of cervical cancer.
